



Schooling Shows THE 2018 SERIES

THE TGIF FUN SHOW SERIES began in May 1979 and has become a Friday night summertime tradition at Centaur. The TGIF Show Series is meant to encourage inexperienced entry-level riders. Green horses should not enter.

DATES

- May 13, May 25, June 22, July 27, Sept 7. (May 13 will start late morning)

CLASSES

Class 1 CADORA INC. WALK/TROT TEST "A"- Test available at <http://www.cadora.ca/dressage-tests> . Horses may be at any level of training. Open to Colts 'N Fillies and Yearlings only

Class 2 CADORA INC. TRAINING LEVEL TEST "B" (amended 2011) (walk, trot, canter)
Test available at <http://www.cadora.ca/dressage-tests> Horses may be at any level of training.

Class 3 "TEST OF CHOICE" You choose the test – we'll judge it...

Dressage test will be ridden in a 20 x 40 meter ring. There is a variety of tests available at <http://www.cadora.ca/dressage-tests> or www.centaurreidingschool.com/links_dr.asp . These tests are free for you to use. If you choose another test, ensure you have legal rights to using chosen test. (EC/DC tests are not allowed). Let us know on the entry form which test you have chosen. (If you forget to choose a test on entry form, show management will choose a test for you!) Winners will be decided by percentage. Open to all. (Colts 'N Fillies may enter if walk/trot test is chosen)

Class 4 SHOWMANSHIP CLASS. Competitor will present his horse (fully tacked up) in hand. Will be asked to stand, walk away, turn around correctly, trot back and stand horse as for a line class. Judged on horse handling skills. Whips are allowed.

Class 5 COLTS 'N FILLIES DRESSAGE EQUITATION Walk & Trot. Colts 'N Fillies may also enter classes 1, 3 (if walk/ trot test), 4, 6 and 17 but are not eligible for other classes.

Class 6 COLTS 'N FILLIES COMMAND CLASS Walk & Trot. Rough riding will be eliminated. Riders in this class may also enter classes 1, 3 (if walk/trot test), 4, 5 & 17 but not eligible for other classes.

Class 7 YEARLINGS DRESSAGE EQUITATION . See Rules for definition of Yearlings

Class 8 YEARLINGS COMMAND CLASS. Rough riding will be eliminated.

Class 9 DRESSAGE EQUITATION - Open

Class 10 HUNTER UNDER SADDLE - Open

Class 11 60cm (2') EQUITATION OVER FENCES - Open (max. height 60cm (2'))

Class 12 60cm (2') HUNTER OVER FENCES - Open (max. height 60cm (2'))

Class 13 70 cm (2'3") EQUITATION OVER FENCES – Open-(max. height 70 cm (2'3"))

Class 14 70 cm (2'3") HUNTER OVER FENCES – Open-(max. height 70 cm (2'3"))

Class 15 45 cm (1'6") EQUITATION OVER FENCES (Max. height 45 cm (1'6")).

Riders may not enter higher 'Over/Fences' classes and must never have completed a course prior to this year. Trotting on course without penalty is allowed. Cross rails only

Class 16 45 cm (1'6") HUNTER OVER FENCES (Max. height 45 cm (1'6")).

Riders may not enter higher 'Over/Fences' classes and must never have completed a course prior to this year. Trotting on course without penalty is allowed. Cross rails only.

Class 17 HORSE KNOWLEDGE QUIZ Entrants are tested orally on horse knowledge plus the Prize List. Class entry fees receive a discount. More info on page 2. Include your age on entry form (see Age Rule). Scores below 60% will not be placed.

Class 18 STICK CLASS. Any and all ages. Decorate your favourite stick pony (or broom handle), train it well, and come show off at the show! Competitors will be asked to halt, walk, trot and even canter! To break ties, reinbacks and flying changes may be asked for. Dress code: none! Rules: No hitting each other with sticks. Ribbons and prizes for all. \$2 entry fee, payable on entry form or start of class.

TIMES

- Dressage classes start at 5:00 pm, Hunter classes at 5:30 pm.
- Warm-up Hunter Over Fences is held between 5:00 and 5:30 pm.

ENTRIES

- FEES: Classes 1, 2, 3: \$25.00/ class **
Classes 4 -16: \$15.00/ class**
Class 17: \$10.00
Class 18: \$2.00 (payable on entry form or at start of class)
**If rider is entered in Class 17, deduct \$2 from each other class entered.
Warm-up Hunter: \$5.00 per round, to be paid upon entering the ring.
(Warm-up Hunter is only for horses already entered in an "over fences" class.)
- **ENTRIES AND ALL FEES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SUNDAY (6:00pm) BEFORE THE SHOW. (Entries for Centaur School Riders close two Sundays before the Show.)**

 - **OR If hand-delivering**, please place in mailbox at the head of private laneway. Mailbox looks like a red barn and is labelled "Show Entries".
 - Do not send entries by courier. Priority Post (no signature required) is acceptable.
 - Faxed entries are accepted WITH an email money transfer received within 12 hours.
 - Email entries are accepted only from scanned copies (not photographs), and with email transfer within 12 hours.
 - For email transfers, use this address: info@centaurridingschool.com. Security word centaur.
 - Entries delivered in any other way may be missed.
 - Please do not call to see if entries have been received. Envelopes are not always opened immediately, and it may not be possible for Secretary to verify.
- Make cheques payable to Shirley Guertin. No post-dated cheques.
- HST is payable on all entry fees.
- **POST AND LATE ENTRIES:** may be accepted, provided riding times have not been set up. Add \$20.00 flat fee for the show.
- A FEE of \$30.00, plus any bank fees, will be charged for cheques that are returned from the bank.

CATEGORY DEFINITIONS

- **COLTS 'N FILLIES:** A competitor in their first season of showing. Colts 'N Fillies may not enter any class requiring them to canter. Classes which may be entered are: 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 17.
- **YEARLINGS:** A competitor who is still very new to competition but has now mastered some canter skills. They must not have won more than three first place ribbons at a show prior to this calendar year, Colts 'n Fillies division excepted. Yearlings may also enter Open classes.
- Riders may reapply for eligibility at the discretion of the show committee.

PRIZES

- **CLASS RIBBONS** will be given to fifth place for all classes. Sponsors are **J.T. BRADLEY'S COUNTRY CONVENIENCE, CASSIO RIBBONS, NAVAN VETERINARY SERVICES**
- **HIGH POINT RIDER** at each show will receive fun prizes.
- Winner of Class 17 - **HORSE KNOWLEDGE QUIZ** - will receive the Honorary Title of **“The Person Who Knows the Most”** and bragging rights.
- **CHAMPIONSHIP RIBBONS** sponsored by **HENRY EQUESTRIAN PLAN** will be given to the top ten horses and top ten riders of the TGIF series.
- **TROPHIES** will be given to the **Top Horse & Top Rider** of the series.
- A **COLTS 'N FILLIES TROPHY** donated by the **NAVAN LIONS CLUB** will be awarded to the rider obtaining the most points for the series in classes 1, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 17.

CENTAUR'S OTHER YEAR-END AWARDS

THE CENTAUR CUP CHALLENGE TROPHY	This beautiful gold cup donated by Centaur Riding School is awarded to the TOP RIDER of all the current year shows held at Centaur.
THE F.X. POTTER EQUITATION TROPHY	This silver cup, donated in 1976 by Mr. F.X. Potter and family , is awarded to Centaur's top equitation student of the current year. All shows count.
ESD / OESS AWARDS	The 3 Centaur ESD / OES competitions will be awarded Ribbons and Prizes for most points earned at all 3 shows. (July 22, Aug 26 & Sept 30)

THE CENTAUR POINT SYSTEM

1st place = 6 pts; 2nd = 4 pts; 3rd = 3 pts; 4th = 2 pts; 5th 1 pt.
Show Coefficients: Gold = 3; Silver = 2; OESS/ESD = 1; TGIF= 1.
TOTAL = Placing points x # of entries in class x Show coefficient

RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

- A copy of a current year negative **Coggins Test** for each horse must accompany entries.
- Riders must wear **protective headgear** and proper footwear at all times while mounted. Juniors **MUST** wear an approved helmet at all times while mounted.
- **DRESS:** Other than approved headgear and safe footwear being mandatory, all other dress is at the discretion of the rider. Should be neat, and form-fitting, but actual show clothes are not necessary.
- **INSURANCE** - Competitors are responsible for all insurance to themselves, employees, owners & horses, etc. All owners are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date. Insurance is available through your OE membership: <http://www.horse.on.ca/membership/index.html>. Riders are asked to send in a photocopy of proof of their liability insurance (or their current year OE Membership card).
- Riders **must wear their numbers** at all times while riding.
- Entries in dressage tests may be limited.
- The same horse may be ridden by two different riders in Classes 1, 15 and 16.
- Boots and bandages will be allowed in the over fences classes but not in any of the flat classes. Martingales in flat classes will be allowed only in Colts 'n Fillies classes.
- Hors Concours entries will not be accepted.
- In case of rain, the show will still be held, with jumping classes being held indoors.
- Refund arrangements for **scratched horses** must be made directly with Shirley Guertin 24 hours before the date of the show. With a vet or medical certificate, all fees, less a \$30.00 scratch fee, will be credited to a later show. There are no refunds for "no shows". Lease fees for Centaur horses are non-refundable.

- **RED RIBBONS IN TAILS:** If your horse kicks and you feel the need to put a red ribbon in its tail, then do not enter this show. This is a show for entry-level riders, and difficult horses should not knowingly be entered.
- **AGE:** The age the rider reaches in the calendar year. For example, if the rider turns 12 anytime in the current year, the rider is considered to be 12 for the entire season.
- Each year we have more children who are over-mounted at the shows. Probably their mounts are fine at home, but put them on the show grounds, away from home, with lots of other horses, AND their rider is nervous and we have had some close calls. This year we are asking judges and committee members to eliminate any riders we believe are unable to control their horses/ponies. This will be a very unfortunate situation for a child with all sorts of dreams. So TRAINERS/PARENTS please make sure that all riders are prepared for the show and suitably mounted. Let's make sure that all riders have a good time.
- **STABLING:** The cost is \$35.00 per box stall and \$30.00 per standing stall per day, or part of a day. Initial bedding is included. Fees must be paid in advance to reserve space. Stalls are limited. Any refunds will be in the form of a credit note. Please indicate time of arrival & departure. **SEND STABLING FEE ON A SEPARATE CHEQUE.** Stall sharing is not allowed and stall lessee will be billed for any other horses occupying their space during the competition. *Stalls will be reserved only after all conditions are met.*
- **PARKING:** There are lights in the parking area in case you are worried about parking in the dark!!
- **Photocopies** of OEF membership or Liability Insurance, and Coggins Tests need only be sent at the first show entered. Please do not re-send the same paperwork at further shows; your information will be kept on file. (*Help save trees!*)

FOR CENTAUR STUDENTS:

Horse Lease Cost:

\$35 per show per rider. if registered in the present session. Classes will be limited to a reasonable number.
\$65 per show per rider. if not registered in the present session.

Coaching fees:

\$30 per show (*per rider*) – if registered in the present session
\$55 per show (*per rider*) – if not registered in present session

Entries for Centaur School Riders close two Sundays before the Show.)
Centaur Riders can deliver entries in usual mailbox in tackroom.

\$10 per show discount may be taken by riders who have participated in show preparatory classes and/ or Show Team Camp, as long as they are registered in the present session. Take deduction in Sub-total, before HST.
