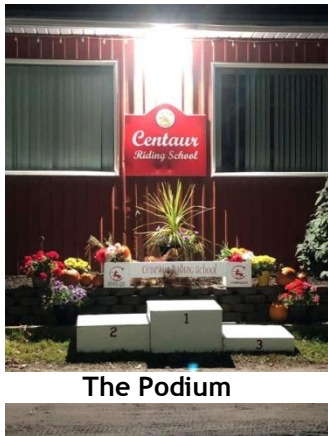

New for 2020 - All 6 OESS shows are partnered with the OADG for 2021 dressage year-end awards.

What is the OESS? - The Ottawa East Schooling Show (OESS) provides a venue for the green rider in both the dressage and hunter rings. Come and compete for great prizes while having fun with your horse in a relaxed atmosphere. This show encourages strong riding skills in dressage and hunter classes for students and school horses yet still offers a challenge for the more seasoned competitor.

The last OESS show of the season will be host to the OESS Year-End Awards Ceremony - each division will be awarded ribbons to the Top of the Season, and the Top Three Riders will be awarded a Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal on the Podium for their year's accomplishments.

What is the OADG? - The Ottawa Area Dressage Group of CADORA is the organization dedicated to encouraging interest and participation in the sport of Dressage in the Ottawa area and its surrounding communities

TIMES

- There will be 2rings: a dressage ring & a hunter ring, but scheduled one after the other.
- Hunter Ring: Hunter Classes may start at 9:00.
- Show schedule and dressage riding times will be posted on the Horse Shows page of www.CentaurRidingSchool.com the day before show, or earlier.
- Warm-up o/f may be held at 8:00 with classes following. If necessary, warm-up time may be moved earlier. Newcomer, Starter & Intro Divisions will have their own warm-up.

Non-OESS, But Counts Towards OADG:

Class 25 TOC Dressage Class. Any class may be entered at Walk/Trot, Training or equivalent level. To be ridden in a 20x40 ring. EC tests are not allowed. Remember to indicate on entry form your test choice.

Extra Information for Dressage Classes:

Walk/Trot Division:

- For riders who are in their first or second year of showing in dressage classes. May also enter any class which does not require cantering. Exception: allowed to enter Newcomer and/or Introductory Hunter Divisions.

Intro -Training Division:

- Who may ride: For riders - in their first or second year of showing at Training Level on any circuit, and/or is under age of 12
- Who May not Ride: Riders who have acted as a coach, or competed on the Silver or Gold circuit.

Training Division: Open to all, except the Intro Training Division Riders

TOC Class: Open to all.

- Make sure to check off your age category on the entry form: Junior or Adult Amateur

Horses are not penalized for simple changes or skipping a change - All distances will be on a 12' stride. Riders will not be penalized for adding a stride. - SECOND refusal = Elimination. Ask permission from judge to take a courtesy fence on way out of ring.

ENTRY FEES & CONDITIONS

- **FEES:**
 - Dressage Tests \$25.00/ class
 - Dressage Division: \$60.00 (3 classes)
 - Hunter Division: \$50.00 (3 classes)
 - Hunter O/F class: \$20.00 per class
 - Warm-up: \$15.00 per round, to be paid on entry form
(Warm-up Hunter is only for horses already entered in "over fences" classes)
 - Admin fee \$15.00
 - Late/Post-Entry fee \$20.00
 - Scratch Fee \$35.00 or \$50 ** see below for conditions
 - Email transfer fee \$1.00

- **Maximum # of classes:** A horse is allowed a maximum of 6 classes per day, with exceptions. An additional division may be allowed for horses in the walk/trot, x-rail types of divisions. Contact show for exception allowance.
- **ENTRIES AND ALL FEES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 6:00 pm TOWEDNESDAYS BEFORE THE SHOW.** (Submit by July 1 for the July 12 show; by July 15 for the July 26 show); by July 22 for August 2 show.
- **ONLY EMAIL ENTRIES ACCEPTED:**
 - Payment must be received within 12 hours
 - If any part of entry or payment is received after closing date, it will be considered late, and late fees will apply.
 - Email entries must send in a scanned copy NOT a photograph.
 - **ETRANSFERS** should be sent to info@CentaurRidingSchool.com, using security word centaur. Please add \$1.00 for email transfer fees
- Centaur Riders can deliver entries in usual mailbox in tackroom.
- Entries will be limited. Enter early to avoid disappointment.
- HST is payable on all entry fees.
- **POST AND LATE ENTRIES:** may be accepted, provided riding times have not been set up. Add \$20.00 flat fee for the show.
- **SCRATCH FEE:** Should a cancellation be necessary no refunds will be given unless the request for same has been given either:
 - before the riding times have been posted - \$35
 - or, between posting and 4:00pm the day preceding show date, \$50
 - Entries paid, less the scratch fee will be refunded to the rider on day of show.
- There are no refunds for "no shows".
- **FOR THE JULY 12 SHOW:** Since we are so later, entries will be accepted without late fee up to Friday July 3.

PRIZES

SHOW PRIZES

- CLASS RIBBONS sponsored by **Centaur Breeding Farm and J.T. BRADLEY'S COUNTRY CONVENIENCE, BRENT FARRIER WORKS, Claire Guertin In Memory of Jean Louis Guertin** will be given to fifth place; if class is large, more ribbons will be awarded.
- Centaur Division Prizes are sponsored by **CASSIO Ribbons, OADG of Cadora, GreenHawk, Centaur Breeding Farm**
- Division CHAMPIONSHIP RIBBONS are sponsored by **HEP**. Ties will be broken as such: Dressage by highest dressage score; Hunters by best equitation flat placing. Must be a minimum of 3 horses in a division for championship to be awarded.
- Point system used to determine Division Awards will be:
1st place= 6 points, 2nd place= 4 pnts; 3rd place= 3 pnts; 4th place=2 pnts; 5th place= 1 point.

OESS YEAR-END AWARDS on Aug 30

There will be special award ceremonies conducted throughout the day at the last show of the year - Aug 30 at Riverview - for each OESS division.

Year-End Points Calculations:

- Points at all shows will count (if you ride in all 6 shows, points from each show will count)
- Must be a minimum of 3 people entered in a division for Year-end medals and ribbons to be awarded

Top riders will receive awards. If you know you will be winning something, but cannot be present, please send a representative.

- Top Three will receive Medals - Gold - Silver - Bronze
- Top riders will each receive a special ribbon
- Gold medal winner will also receive a special award.



Point system:

1st place = 6 pts; 2nd = 4 pts; 3rd = 3 pts; 4th = 2 pts; 5th = 1pt.
TOTAL = Placing points x # of entries in class

OADG YEAR-END AWARDS at Nov. 2021 Banquet

DUE TO COVID THERE WILL NOT BE A BANQUET IN 2020, NOR YEAR-END OADG AWARDS. HOWEVER RIDERS MAY CARRY EARNED POINTS FORWARD TO 2021. Note that 2020 OADG memberships are extended to include 2021.

At the Year-End OADG Banquet, Medallions will be presented in the following 6 categories:
W/T Junior, W/T Adult Amateur, W/T Eq (Jr/AA combined), W/T/C Eq (Jr/AA combined), Training Junior and Training Adult Amateur.

To qualify for these awards, both rider and horse owner must be members of the OADG. A 2020 membership also counts for 2021. One membership fee = 2 years!

OESS GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

- **Maximum # of classes:** A horse is allowed a maximum of 6 classes per day, with exceptions. An additional division may be allowed for horses in the walk/trot, x-rail types of divisions. Contact show for exception allowance.
- Commonly accepted practices in each discipline will govern. Please ask horse show management if you have any questions, keeping in mind that some modifications may be made to allow for the inexperience of some competitors.
- Divisions may be split or combined at show secretary's discretion
- **Memberships:**
 - 1) Owners & riders must be current members of Ontario Equestrian. Photocopies of current membership cards must be sent with entries. For info about OE go to <https://ontarioequestrian.ca/membership/>
 - 2) To qualify for OADG Year-End Awards, both rider and horse owner must be OADG members. <https://ottawadressage.ca/renew/>
- **Acceptance of Risk:** Neither Centaur Riding School, nor Riverview Stables, its volunteers, show organizers, helpers, staff members, or their families shall in any way be held responsible for any accident, injury, death, damage or loss of property of any competitor or visitor to show sites. An Acceptance of Risk form must be signed by each competitor and horse owner.
- A copy of a current year negative Coggins Test for each horse must accompany entries. No exceptions.
- Every person mounted on a horse must wear an ASTM approved riding helmet properly fastened at all times they are mounted on a horse, as well as proper riding footwear.
- Riders must wear their numbers at all times while riding.
- Only "legal" bits will be allowed.
- If a horse is observed to be lame, sick, unsound or in distress, the judge or the show organizer will excuse the horse from further classes.
- A rider falling off in the show ring is immediately excused. Re-mounting in the show ring is not allowed. This includes the warm-up round
- It is the Rider's responsibility to enter divisions for which qualified. If incorrect division is entered and this is only noticed later on in season, all points earned in incorrect division will be forfeited.
- **TOC:** Chosen test will not be changed once show starts. Verify your test with posted times to make sure it's the correct one.
- See the OESS Facebook page to keep up-to-date, and to see show results.
- At times we have children who are over-mounted at the shows. Probably their mounts are fine at home, but put them on the show grounds, away from home, with lots of other horses, AND their rider is nervous and we have had some close calls. This year we are asking judges and committee members to eliminate any riders we believe are unable to control their horses/ponies. This will be a very unfortunate situation for a child with all sorts of dreams. So TRAINERS/PARENTS please make sure that all riders are prepared for the show and suitably mounted. Let's make sure that all riders have a good time.

OADG GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

- All classes in the dressage portion of this competition are part of the OADG Non-Permit Schooling Show circuit.
- In order to qualify for OADG awards, both the rider and the owner of the horse (if different) must be members of the OADG. 2020 Memberships are being carried forward into 2021.
- For the purpose of year-end awards, only the rider's scores will be tracked. A rider may ride different horses at different competitions. This is an exception given by the OADG for the Non-permit Schooling awards only.
- At the 2021 November annual banquet the OADG will be presenting medallions to W/T Junior, W/T Adult Amateur, W/T Eq (Jr/AA combined), W/T/C Eq (Jr/AA combined), Training Junior and Training Adult Amateur.
- Riders must compete in a minimum of 3 shows at 2 venues.
- Scores will be sent by Show Secretary to the OADG for calculation, do make sure to check off Junior or AA on your entry form
- The OADG will verify membership, so no need to send proof of membership with entry

CENTAUR GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION

- **STABLING:** The cost is \$45/day per stall. No stall sharing. No refunds in case of a scratch. Add \$20 for overnight fee if arriving after 5:00 pm on previous day.
- No Dogs please.
- There will not be a canteen available on site.
- Hors Concours entries may be accepted at Centaur's discretion. Please call ahead.
- A limit will be placed on the number of entries accepted. If you have entered late, please verify with the show secretary to ensure your entry has been accepted. Please **DO NOT ASSUME** that a late entry will be automatically accepted.
- All fees must be paid before show closing date. This rule will be strictly adhered to. In case of rain, the show will still be held, with over fences classes being held indoors.
- In case of unforeseen circumstances necessitating the cancellation of the show, the show will be held on an alternate date and all entries will be automatically forwarded to said date. If rider needs to scratch see "Scratch rule".

COVID-19 Restrictions:

1. No spectators. Riders can bring their coach, 1 groom, and a parent or guardian if under the age of 18
2. Riders wanting to enter a flat class must enter the division. Entries in flat classes will need to qualify through their tests (dressage) or over fences (hunter). Only the top 8 riders (after the dressage tests or hunter rounds) will participate in the flat class.
3. Please bring water for your horses
4. Please take all your garbage home with you
6. Hunter riders will be called into the warm-up ring with the other members of their stable
7. Everyone should keep physically distanced at all time.
8. No Canteen will be present, however cold water will be available
9. All entry forms and payments should be sent by e-mail
10. Trailer parking will be in the woods
