Horses are not penalized for simple changes or skipping a change</li> <li>- All distances will be on a 12' stride. Riders will not be penalized for adding a stride.</li> <li>- SECOND refusal = Elimination. Ask permission from judge to take a courtesy fence on way out of ring.</li> </ul>

### FEES for HUNTER

- Hunter Division: \$50.00 (3 classes)
- Hunter O/F class: \$20.00 per class
- Hunter flat class: \$15.00 per class
- Warm-up: \$15.00 per round, to be paid on entry form  
 (Warm-up Hunter is only for horses already entered in "over fences" classes)

### PRIZES

- RIBBONS will be given to fifth place
- Classes will be split into Juniors & Seniors if entries warrant.
- Dressage Championship Ribbons for Senior and Junior Riders, determined by two highest test scores.
- Hunter Championship Ribbons will be given out for divisions having a minimum of 4 entries
- High score prizes will be given out.
- **VERSATILITY AWARD** – to the rider with the highest dressage score who has also entered/completed a hunter division

Show Coefficients: Schooling = 1.5; TGIF= 1.

TOTAL = Placing points x # of entries in class x Show coefficient

## STABLING

- a) Cost is \$55.00 per box stall and \$45.00 per standing stall per show day, or part of a day. (Show day = 6:30 a.m. to 1 hour after show end.) Add \$25 per stall if overnight. (Overnight = from 5:00 pm on. Earlier arrivals than 5:00 pm = a full day. Please indicate time of arrival & departure.
- b) Stalls will be assigned in following order: 1) first choice to any horse arriving the day before; 2) second choice will be in the order received/paid
- c) Initial bedding of straw is included. If you do not want straw bedding let us know 48 hours prior start of show, and the stall will be left bare. You will need to bring your own bedding.
- d) Fees must be paid in advance to reserve space. Stalls are limited. **SEND STABLING FEE ON A SEPARATE CHEQUE.** If a stall is not available, cheque will be returned to competitor. If stabling fee has been added to entry fee cheque, refunds will be as a credit note only.
- e) Stall sharing is not allowed and stall lessee will be billed for any other horses occupying their space during the competition. Stalls will be reserved only after all conditions are met.
- f) Crossies will be out of bounds.
- g) SCRATCHES: Half of stall fee will be credited if scratched min. of 48 hours before start of competition.
- h) TACK STALL is available for \$45. Only 3 tack stalls available, size of a standing stall.

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW...

1. **COMPETITION MANAGER** is Shirley Guertin.
2. **SEND** entries to Centaur Riding School, 3845 Frank Kenny Road, Navan, Ont., K4B 0C6.
  - i. **Priority Post** (no signature required) is acceptable. Do not send entries by courier.
  - ii. **Hand-delivering**: please place in mailbox at the head of private laneway. Mailbox is labeled "Show Entries". (mailbox looks like a red barn)
  - iii. **Faxed** entries are accepted WITH an email money transfer received within 12 hours.
  - iv. **Email entries** are accepted only from scanned copies (not photographs), and with email transfer within 12 hours.
3. **PAYMENT**:
  - i. Etransfers - use this address: [info@centaurridingschool.com](mailto:info@centaurridingschool.com). Security word **centaur**. There is an additional fee for etransfers if not received within 12 hours of entries.
  - ii. **CHEQUES** must be made payable to Shirley Guertin. No post-dated cheques. A FEE of \$50.00 will be charged for cheques that are returned from the bank for any reason.
4. **COGGINS TEST**: a copy of a current year negative Coggins test must accompany entries.
5. **CLOSING DATE**: **July 30**, or when full. Entries and all fees **MUST BE RECEIVED** by closing date. Entries are accepted on a first come basis. They will be closed as soon as the day is full.
6. **LATE ENTRIES** may be accepted, provided riding times have not been set up. An additional fee of \$30 will be charged. For such entries, be prepared to pay via an email money transfer. Without payment, the entry will not be accepted. Any part of the entry received after closing date is considered a late entry.
7. **SWAPPING HORSE AND/OR RIDER** into already entered classes will be accepted up to 24 hours prior start of show with a \$30 additional fee. Horse and/or Rider must be up to date on all paperwork.
8. **SCRATCHES**: For entries scratched before the closing date, administration fee will be retained and the balance along with all other fees will be returned to exhibitor. Entries scratched before riding times have been posted will forfeit administration fee and will have 50% of entry fees credited to a later show; entries scratched after times have been posted will forfeit administration fee and will have 25% of entry fees credited to a later show. Credits allowed provided a vet or medical certificate is in the hands of the show secretary before the end of the show. All other withdrawals of entries are non-refundable. "No-shows" will forfeit all refunds. All cancellations must be made in writing.
9. **DECISIONS**: Commonly accepted practices in each discipline will govern. Please ask horse show management if you have any questions. All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the Competition Manager, her decision to be final. The Competition Manager further reserves the right to cancel, combine, change any class and to limit entries.
10. **DRESSAGE TESTS** – CADORA tests will be used - <http://www.cadora.ca/dressage-tests/>
  - a. **TOC** – Test of choice. Please indicate on your entry form the test you wish to ride.
  - b. **RING SIZE** – if fewer entries, all tests may be ridden in the 20x60 ring
  - c. **START TIMES** will be posted at [www.CentaurRidingSchool.com](http://www.CentaurRidingSchool.com) by the Thursday prior show. Please do not call for riding times. Classes will not necessarily be run in the sequence on the prize list.
11. **COMMUNICATION** will be done through email only. Please ensure your correct address is added to the entry form, or you may be left out of the loop!
12. **HORS CONCOURS** entries may be accepted if there is room.
13. Horses that are not entered in the show will not be admitted to the show grounds.
14. **SAFETY HEADGEAR** - All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear properly fitted and fastened safety approved protective headgear at all times when mounted.
15. **COMPETITION NUMBERS** must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring. Please return numbers at end of day.
16. **PARKING** – trailers will park in the woods. Please use the South Entrance, and drive straight through to the woods. Feel free to ask for "gator services" for helping transport equipment, water back and forth.
17. **COVID** – we all know the drill, please abide by O Regs of the day
18. **INSURANCE** – liability insurance for rider and horse must be in place. Proof must be submitted with entries. (an OE membership will cover such coverage)
